Fresh Applications are invited from the students with disabilities (*with minimum 40% benchmark disability*) for the Meritorious Scholarship from CLASS - XI onwards for the Current Academic Year of 2025-26, which is being implemented by The Government of Meghalaya through The State Resource Centre on Disability Affairs (SRCDA), Civil Hospital, Shillong.

The amounts of the monthly Scholarship from the different Categories/Streams of Higher & Technical Education are as follows:

Class XI & XII	₹2,000/- (per month)
Graduate Level (General, Honours, B. Ed., etc.)	₹3,000/- (per month)
Post Graduate (MA, M.Ed., Engineering, LLB, etc.)	₹4,000/- (per month)
Professional & Technical Courses (M. Phil, PhD, M. Tech, MBBS, etc.)	₹5,000/- (per month)

The interested students with disabilities who are permanent residents of Meghalaya may collect the Application Forms on payment of ₹20/- (Rupees twenty only) per form from the following Centres:

The duly filled up forms may be submitted to the offices of the aforementioned Centres on or before 11th December, 2025 during official working hours.
